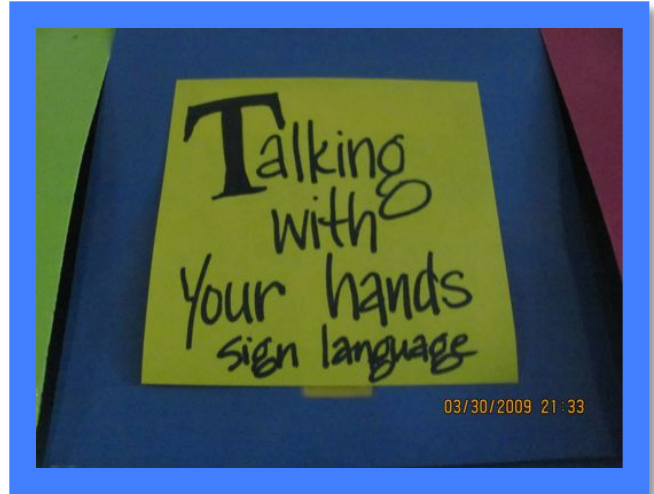

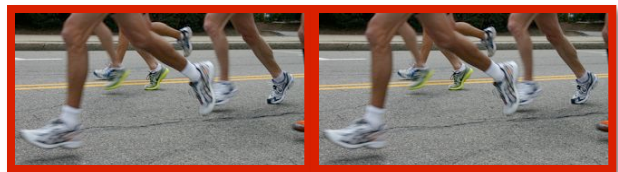
Spring Fling Huge Success

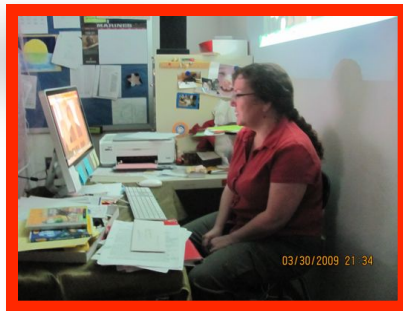
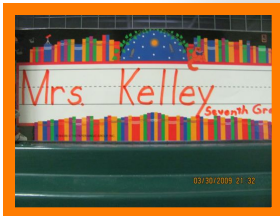
